As you already are aware, Governor Doug Ducey has announced statewide school closures to take effect March 16th through March 27th. We recognize that our families are being impacted in many ways during this unprecedented time and that family routines may be different. Cienega High School and our Bobcat Nation staff will do our very best to provide your family support while at the same time taking care of our own families' needs.

Our district leadership team and Cienega teachers are creating a plan on how to provide stability, connections, and general education opportunities while our campus is closed. During the week of March 23rd, your Cat's teachers will reach out to students and families via phone or email. On Wednesday, March 25th, our Bobcat teachers will send out recommended activities, via Schoology, for students to work on while our Cats classes are not hosted on our site.
