

Intermediate Art Supply List

For At Home Learning

I want to begin by letting you know how excited I am that you have chosen to take Art as one of your electives this year! Obviously art is a challenging class to switch from an on-campus setting to an at-home setting BUT we're going to do our very best to replicate the experience you would have in my classroom in your home for as long as we need to have distance learning.

To make this transition as similar as possible to what you would experience on campus, you need to set yourself up with a **variety of art supplies** that we can use to make some excellent artwork at home. Normally you would pay a \$40 class fee at the beginning of the year and we would use those funds to buy class sets of supplies for you and your classmates to use throughout the year. However, because we are all starting school in our homes, I am going to have to rely on you to provide your own supplies...at least until we return to campus.

The supply list I am providing will be a good starting off point for us and depending how much time we end up having to spend at home, I may request that you get more supplies later. With that said, the more time we spend at home, the less class fee I will ask you to pay once we return to campus. I know art supplies can start to cost a lot of money, so I don't want to over burden you with purchases.

Basic Supplies

- Glue (stick and liquid)
- Pencils
- Erasers

- Scissors
- Exacto Knife or Box cutter
