The Transportation Department drives thousands of miles each day to transport thousands of students to and from school safely and efficiently. This is our single most-important goal. As we prepare for the new school year, it is important to familiarize yourself with your student's route information.

Transportation routes have changed significantly, therefore, please check your student's bus stop information carefully, following the directions below. This is especially important for high school students as we have added "hubs" to current routing schedules which are designed to allow for more direct routes to school thereby minimizing ridership times and increasing our efficiency. This also provides a foundation for transportation zones that will take effect in the 2021/2022 school year.

All students who are eligible for transportation are assigned to a bus route. Excluding special needs students, all students are assigned to a single bus route based on their home address.

Route information is available online at <http://www.infofinderi.com/tfi/> . To find your bus stop, type in your street address, school of attendance, grade, and zip code. Then click the "my bus stops" button. The published information will give you bus route numbers and pick up and drop off times for full day and half day schedules.

We appreciate your support as well as the fundamental role you have in helping Transportation staff ensure the safety of all our students.
