Transition to In-Person Instruction

Dear Parents,

As conditions surrounding COVID-19 are improving, we are making plans to expand in-person instruction.

The following is being considered with tentative plans to begin on March 22, 2021:

- All schools will continue with the current start and end times to the day.
- Elementary schools will return to in-person instruction five days a week.
- Middle and high schools will return to in-person instruction four days a week, Monday through Thursday, with Fridays remaining asynchronous.

We are also planning to maintain Brick to Click instruction for families who need that option.

You can expect more details coming from your child's school in the coming days regarding the specifics of these plans at their respective school. Your child's school will also contact you regarding your preference for in-person instruction or Brick-to-Click instruction.

Once these plans have been finalized, I will make a recommendation to our Governing Board for consideration. I expect this final decision to take place no later than at our regularly scheduled board meeting on March 9th.
